



Proposed By Laws Changes

The State of Michigan has changed the requirement of a nonprofit corporation to have a president, vice president, secretary, treasurer and three directors. Our bylaws only allow for two directors and should be amended to comply with this requirement. We will discuss this change and vote on it at our August business meeting.

Sections Requiring Changes

Section 8.1

The Executive Committee shall consist of the President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, National Director, Alternate National Director, the Director at large and the immediate Past President.

Section 8.3

The Executive Committee shall consist of the President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, National Director, Alternate National Director, the Director at large and the immediate Past President.

Section 8.4.7

The Director at large - Shall represent the membership at large and may fill in for the National Director and the Alternate National Director at the FMCA convention in their absence.

Section 8.8

Chapter Officers shall hold office for approximately one year commencing with the October meeting and ending with the succeeding October meeting. No Officer shall serve for more than three consecutive terms in any given office and no member shall serve as an Officer in any capacity for more than five consecutive terms, excepting the National Director, and the Alternate National Director and the Director at large who may be reelected indefinitely.

Section 9.2

The Committee will nominate candidates for all Chapter Officers, National Director, and Alternate National Director and the Director at large.
