


Membership Meeting Minutes

Midland, MI September 14, 2013

Call to Order: President Dick Balsley called the September 2013 Membership Meeting to order at 9:00 AM Minutes of the August 16, 2013 meeting were read and approved. Treasurer's Report: Treasurer Teresa Little reported the financial status. The report was approved. Old Business:

2013 *Rally Planning* – Frank Griffin said the October rally is camping Monday through Wednesday with a family style dinner in an Amish home Wednesday evening. The Shipshewana Flea Market will be on Tuesday and Wednesday. We will be camping at the Shipshewana South campground. There will be a seminar on refrigeration and possibly another on generators.

2014 Rally Planning – Ed Dohm said the May rally, which will be hosted by the club officers, will be in Eastern MI or Northern OH. The June rally will be June 8-10 and it will be held at Potato Creek State Park, south of South Bend, IN. Phyllis and Steve Thornburg will host. The July rally will be July 17-19 at the Wayne County Fairground, MI. Lee and Lil Skalski will host. The August rally is still open at this time. Walt and Marlene Scarlett will host the September rally. They are planning on a site in the western Michigan fruit belt. The October rally will be at Turkeyville in Marshall, MI, hosted by Dick and Jan Serreyn.

Non-Active Membership Category – Dick Balsley said the special membership category is to accommodate the folks who have gotten to the point, due to health or age, etc. they have to stop using their GMC and to stop RVing, but want to remain a part of the association with their friends. The description of the status could include wording such as "have sold their GMC and are not pursuing ownership of another RV". It is Dick's perception that the Associate Member will be included in the Membership Directory and they will receive the club directory and newsletters. They will not be required to be FMCA members and they will not be included in the membership list the club sends to FMCA. They would have a non-voting status and would not be permitted to attend club business meetings. The Associate Member will be allowed to attend some rally functions, but not allowed to attend every rally. It is acknowledged that anyone can utilize camping facilities that are open to the public and if they choose a facility where a Great Lakers rally is in progress, they can certainly associate with members of the Great Lakers.

John Pryzbylek suggested using the term "Former Member" and not being concerned whether they choose to purchase another RV. **D. Balsley** said the concern with club members moving away from GMCs and into other types of RVs is the club might change its focus from support, maintenance and enjoyment of the GMC motorhomes to that of becoming a "travel club" with only the trips as its main focus. Lee Skalski asked why we need to have a membership category for inactive people. If they want to receive newsletters, membership directories, etc., they can simply purchase an annual subscription. Charles Mullaly suggested we should simplify the process by first establishing a membership category for those club members who have given up RVing, then secondly address the status of members who move from their GMC to another category of RV.

Club Trailer – Dick Balsley said there are pictures and some description of the trailer in the latest newsletter. The sealed bid auction is now in effect and a minimum bid of \$500.00 is required. Sealed bids are to be submitted no later than the October 2013 rally. The bids will be opened at the October Officers meeting and the winning bid will be announced at the Membership meeting.

New Business:

Nominating Committee – President Balsley asked for volunteers for a nominating committee to raise a slate of officers for 2015. There were no volunteers at this time.

Club Logo Clothes – Judy Dohm reported she has a source for sweatshirts and t-shirts printed with the Great Lakers club logo. She said sweatshirts will cost \$ 13 in any color up to size 1X and in sizes 2X to 5X are \$15, plus \$15 for a single color print. Each additional color in the print will cost \$5. Membership Meeting Minutes

Shipshewana, IN October 16, 2013

Call to Order: President Dick Balsley called the October 2013 Membership Meeting to order at 9:20 AM Minutes of the September 14, 2013 meeting were read and approved. Zoe Johnson advised that son Steve and his wife Becky were guests at the Midland rally and have subsequently become Great Lakers members. Treasurer's Report: Treasurer Teresa Little was absent from the October meeting. There was no Treasurer's Report presented.

Old Business:

2014 Rally Planning – Ed Dohm said the rally plans are as follows:

May 16 – 18 will be in Wauseon, OH at Sunny's Campground. Hosted by Club Board Members. Arrangements are being made by John and Debra Pryzbylek.

June 8-10 will be held at Potato Creek State Park, south of South Bend, IN. Phyllis and Steve Thornburg will host. This rally will be followed immediately by the GLAMA rally in Goshen, IN beginning on June 11 and running till the 17th. **July 15-17** will be at the Wayne County Fairground in Bellville, MI. Lee and Lil Skalski will host.

August 30 - 31 will be at Selfridge Air Force Base, Harrison, MI, approximately 30 miles North of Detroit. The dates coincide with an air show. The on-base camp ground is small with only 30 full hook-up sites. Additional sites will be available but may be dry camping. There will be no towed vehicles allowed on the airbase and rally attendees will not be permitted to leave and re-enter the base until after the air show.

September 12 - 14 will be in South Haven, MI. The rally will be hosted by Walt and Marlene Scarlett. October 16 - 18 will be at Turkeyville in Marshall, MI. The rally will be hosted by Dick and Jan Serreyn. Ed Dohm said the July and October 2015 rallies are also tentatively planned.

Pat Lintner, Sr. Vice President of the Great Lakes Area MotorCoach Association spoke about the GLAMA rally for 2014 which will be held in Goshen, IN, June 11-17. He said the 2013 rally was attended by 469 coaches and 85 vendors. The GMC coaches are recognized as having relatively small holding tanks, so the GMC coaches will be guaranteed full hookup sites with 30 amp electric, and if the GMCs are registered together, they will be parked together. Each FMCA chapter will be assigned a shelter for the entire rally period and Thursday will be set aside as a day for chapter activities. Towed vehicle parking will be on the same site as its coach rather than in a remote parking lot so the vehicles can be used for onsite transportation. There will also be golf cart "taxis" available.

He called for a vote on acceptance of the proposed wording and the membership voted unanimously to accept the proposal. The detailed wording will be published in the club newsletter. **Red Hickman** asked for an explanation of the differential in annual dues of \$20 for the Associate Members and \$35 for regular members. **Jim White** said the Associate Member dues are intended to cover the cost of receiving the annual membership directory and the club newsletters. The regular membership dues are to cover those things as well as the costs of operating the club.

Club Trailer – Dick Balsley said there were three sealed bids received from club members for purchase of the trailer. Dick Olmstead submitted the highest bid of \$2,100 is now the owner of the trailer. The proceeds from the sale will be put into the general treasury and may allow for some future special projects.

Club Logo Clothes – Judy Dohm reported the sweatshirts ordered at the September rally are in process. When she receives them, she will mail them to the purchasers. More detailed information about the shirts and costs will be published in the club newsletter.

New Business:

Nominating Committee – President Balsley asked for volunteers for a nominating committee to raise a slate of officers for 2015. Utilizing the well proven GI method of finding volunteers, Dick announced that the Nominating committee is Lee Skalski, Frank Griffin and Dale Ropp. Becky Johnson has volunteered to take on the position of club Treasurer. **First time rally attendees** Don and Liz Luse and Russel and Nancy Nolan were introduced. First timers Vincent and Sharon Perfetto were not available for introduction. Steve and Becky Johnson were introduced as first timers as club members. Also introduced were guests Pat and Victoria Lintner as GLAMA representatives. Other guests attending the rally were Maxine Ropp, Dale's mother and Cindy Hoover, daughter of Dick and Kathy Wilson.
