For those of you that need to replace your beat up or damaged rear inner dust seals (caps), NAPA has a good Heavy Duty Gold colored unit. Your NAPA number is NOE 7351425 in the NAPA Solutions product line. The pricing is in the mid \$6 range depending on where you live. This is a shorter cap and will work with your Alex Serum aluminum GMC covers.

Are you looking for a Schrader Valve for your air bags then Ace Hardware has them under Part# BAV1/4BLKLF. Lowes carries them as an air valve with a part# A-738 and it is made by Watts.

For those of you that are running a vacuum pump to augment you engine vacuum, Superior Solution has a Universal Adj. Vacuum Switch with a 6-22 range. You can find them on EBay for about \$29. I add one when I add the Ford high volume pump and it works great.
