



# Michigan Adventure Rally

## August 29, 30 & 31

The GMC Great Lakers August 2016 rally will be at Duck Creek RV Resort near Muskegon, MI.

The rally fee is \$125 per two-person coach and \$115 per single person coach.

We have 30 campsites reserved. Any sites not committed by July 4 will cost the Great Lakers a penalty fee if they are held beyond that date or they will be released from our reservation block. So, if you are unable to send your reservation and fee to Becky Johnson before July 4, let her know if you want to reserve a site by that date and make sure you send her your payment by August 15.

Arrival is planned for August 29 and departure on August 31. For additional camping nights the fee is \$50 per night if you identify yourself as part of the GMC Great Lakers rally group. Make your arrangements for extra nights directly with Duck Creek RV Resort.

The camping sites are all level concrete pads with concrete fire rings and picnic tables at each site. All sites are full hook-ups with 50 amp electric service and cable TV. There are few shade trees but lots of room for awnings. The resort offers a swimming pool, with adult's only hours, a hot tub and a nice dog yard. Visitors are welcome with a charge of \$3 per day; visitors aged 55 and over are free. There is a large playground for children.

We plan to have breakfast in the clubhouse Tuesday and Wednesday. Monday evening we will go to a local restaurant for dinner – order from the menu. Tuesday night we will have a "salad pot-luck"- bring your favorite salad. Meat and dessert will be provided.

The Duck Creek RV Resort is located across the street from Michigan Adventure, a theme park that is or has been affiliated with Cedar Point. It is between Muskegon and Whitehall.

**NOTE:** For those with pets on board, proof of current rabies vaccination will be required at check-in.
