





## **Corporation Bylaws Revision Required by FMCA**

On November 16, 2016 FMCA notified the GMC Great Lakers Motorhome Club Inc. our bylaws are not in compliance with the national requirements Policy and Procedures 3011/A *Minimum Requirements for Chapter Bylaws* and 3011/B *Chapter Bylaws Format*.

FMCA last reviewed our bylaws in 2010 and stated a number of changes have been made to the FMCA National Bylaws since that time and "a number of clauses included in the minimum requirements are missing or incomplete. Your bylaws also include considerable information that would be more appropriately included in Standing Rules, for example, expansion of officer duties, instructions regarding rallies and limitations regarding expenditures."

Our vice-president volunteered to spearhead the effort revising the bylaws to be compliant with the FMCA Policies and Procedures 3011/A and 3011/B, the minimum requirements, and also implement the FMCA recommendation to prepare a Standing Rules document containing the detailed day-to-day administrative operating procedures of the Corporation. This effort is well underway and draft documents will be reviewed by the Executive Board during the May rally.
