





The Solar Eclipse Rally



The joint rally of the GMC Eastern States and GMC Great Lakers was held at the Fern Lake Campground, Paducah, KY August 18-22. Thirty two coaches registered for the rally but mechanical, family and personal problems reduced the number of participating coaches to 25.

Tom Whitton, a local GMC owner and member of GMCES, did an admirable job in promoting the rally with the local television station, The Paducah Sun newspaper, visitors bureau, police department and campground.

Friday evening began with a pizza and salad dinner hosted by Kris and Larry Whisler of the GMCES. The Great Lakers provided the coffee and continental breakfasts throughout the rally and the Eastern States provided several informal lunches and a chili and pasta dinner.

Saturday morning, the local television station reporter and cameraman arrived, filmed several coaches, interviewed the presidents of both clubs and various club members. Fowler Black, Director of the Paducah Visitors Bureau, made a presentation to the group about the history of Paducah, it's connection to William Clark, of Lewis and Clark fame, the significance of the mural flood wall and it's artwork and notable attractions including the National Quilt Museum. Twenty blocks of the city's downtown have been designated as a historic district and listed on the National Register of Historic Places. A motorcade of seven coaches proceeded downtown and spent several hours visiting the city. The local television station led their nightly news broadcast with the segment filmed at the campground.

Sunday began with a tech session led by Bob Stone on the Hydro-Boost Brake System followed by a visit by a reporter from The Paducah Sun, beer tasting, shopping excursions and a group dinner.

Monday began with a newspaper article on our rally published in the newspaper, a flea market of GMC parts and paraphernalia followed by the main event—the solar eclipse and distribution of the Eclipse T-shirts designed by Kris Whisler. Viewing glasses were available for the participants and several folks brought welding helmets or welding lens to view the moon passing in front of the sun. Totality lasted for two minutes twenty-one seconds, viewable with the naked eye. Quite a spectacular event! In case you missed this one, the next total eclipse in our area will take place on April 8, 2024, with 3 minutes 51 seconds of totality in Cleveland, Ohio!

September 2017 Rally Summary

The Great Lakers' September Rally was held at the Elkhart Campground, Elkhart, Indiana in conjunction with the 35th Anniversary Convention of GMCMI. A total of 154 GMC coaches participated in the Fall Convention, September 15-21, 2017 and included thirty-one first timers. The convention included over twenty-three hours of technical seminars, fifteen hours of non-technical seminars, three ice cream socials, a Craft and Flea Market and participation by numerous GMC vendors.

Alex Ferrara was awarded the GMCMI Guardian Spirit Award for his unselfish commitment to improve the steering of GMC coaches for owners. As the convention ended, Alex has worked on the steering mechanism of 169 coaches since he began the program.

The Pineblock Derby was delayed one day due to an electronic malfunction but the problem was later identified, repaired and race completed with Laurie Burton's car the overall winner!

The Great Lakers Get Together was held on Monday, September 18th that began with a catered dinner served to the 89 members and guests followed by a business meeting. FMCA has reviewed our revised Constitution and Bylaws and found them to be compliant with the requirements of FMCA.

An anonymous 2017 Great Lakers Rally Survey was handed out to the members at the rally. The purpose of the 20 question survey was to obtain input from the membership about our current rally format, what's working well, what needs improvement, rally costs, preferred rally length, etc. If you did not attend the rally, the survey can be printed from the Great Lakers website and mailed to Becky Johnson. Becky will compile the results of the survey and the data will be published in the GL newsletter.
