



## **2019 CARAVAN RALLY**

At the October 2017 rally we introduced the idea of a GMC Great Lakers caravan rally that would take a number of our coaches on a Lake Superior Circle Tour in 2019. To determine a level of interest in the tour we asked for a show of hands of people who are interested in pursuing information about a caravan rally. The interest level appeared to be quite high so we will begin with a description of a similar rally we did in July and August 2017. We had 12 total coaches in our group and we travelled in groups of 3 so we didn't clog the highways with a large group of slower moving vehicles. We travelled at speeds of 50 – 55 MPH. We had all campground reservations made and deposits paid well before the start of the trip. The group size of 12 coaches worked very well and allowed us to get group reservations at all the campgrounds.

The trip began at Mill Creek RV Park at Mackinaw City, MI, and ended at the Aune Osborn Campground at Ste. St. Marie, MI, 14 days later. We travelled approximately 1200 miles going clockwise around Lake Superior. Travel days ranged from 120 miles to 200 miles. Our stops were at Munising, MI (2 nights), Copper Harbor, MI (2 nights), Cedar, WI (2 nights), Duluth, MN (1 night), Thunder Bay, ONT (3 nights), Nipigon, ONT (2 nights), Wawa, ONT (1 night), and Ste. St. Marie, MI (1 night).

Because all of the campground reservations were made far in advance and were un-changeable, we had to arrive at each destination on schedule. Each group of 3 coaches was free to make whatever sightseeing stops along the way or take whatever side trips as long as they arrived at the designated destination as planned. Individual coaches could do the same with the knowledge of their travelling partners. We made coordinated fuel stops and lunch stops. We had a designated leader and designated "tail gunner" for each group of three and those jobs could be alternated for each travel day.

Communication in our group was with CB radios, some groups used HAM radios and some used cell phones. We found that our cell phones (ATT) were basically just paperweights in Canada.

On non-travel days we were free to sightsee, shop or just relax and take naps.

For meals, we had a few restaurant dinners, we had several potluck dinners, for lunches we were on our own, and breakfast was assigned to one or two coaches who would provide something like egg casserole, waffles, scrambled eggs, etc. There was always coffee and juice made by the Wagon Master. Everyone pitched in so we ate very well.

The cost of the rally was \$100 earnest money to ensure our spot in the caravan and make some early deposits, required about a year before the caravan; then \$500 to pay for all of our campgrounds for the entire tour. That had to be paid in January to ensure all campgrounds were paid in advance. Additional costs were fuel and any sightseeing and souvenir expenses we chose to make.

The Canadian portion of the trip requires a current passport or enhanced drivers license and very current health certificates for any pets.
