These are some of the close ones that you will enjoy seeing. Other more distant ones we will discuss at another time.



## **GMC GREAT LAKERS HISTORY – Part 5**

### **1980 A Year Outside FMCA**

The Great Lakers celebrated the Club's fourth birthday on February 23<sup>rd</sup> at the Detroit Plaza. At a short meeting the new officers were installed, they are: Virgil Barbe, President; Emmit Dennis, Vice President; Jim Kellerman, Treasurer; Pinky Staub, Secretary and Ron Kirkland, National Director.

The Club started the camping season at King's Island the weekend of April 25<sup>th</sup>. A caravan was planned from the rest area on I-75 at Bowling Green, Ohio to King's Island on Friday. Seventeen (17) coaches participated in the weekend activities, which included a great potluck supper on Saturday, and pancakes on Sunday morning.

The May rally at Washaki Recreation Area in Lapeer, Michigan was attended by twelve (12) coaches. The matter of insurance was discussed at the business meeting. The insurance is the umbrella policy by Alexander and Alexander through the FMCA.

Nineteen (19) coaches attended the June rally at the Monroe County KOA, located on US-23 at the Summerfield Road exit just 15 minutes north of Toledo, Ohio. At the business meeting, it was decided to go with FMCA for insurance for the Club's rallies.

The Club was saddened to learn of the death of its treasurer, Jim Kellerman on Sunday July 20.

The August rally was held at the Wolverine Campground near Flint, Michigan. The weather was good for some to play golf while others took the train ride on The Huckleberry Railroad and visited The Crossroads Village. The usual potluck supper on Saturday night was filled with lots of super goodies brought by all the good cooks in the Club. Sunday mornings pancake breakfast was a little damp, but there were lots of customers in line to eat. After breakfast a short church service was held.

At the business meeting on Saturday the Club's newly appointed Treasurer, Bill Helmore, was introduced. He will serve out the remainder of Jim Kellerman's term.

The Club gathered at Juniper Hills Campground just south of Brooklyn, Michigan on the third weekend of September. The campground is adjacent to Michigan International Speedway where three races were held on Saturday, champion cars (Indy), stock cars and super V's (Volkswagen).

Valley Plaza at Midland, Michigan was the site for the October rally. Fourteen (14) coaches braved the cool weather for a weekend of swimming in the indoor pool or just sitting around. After a sit-down dinner, a short business meeting was held at which time the new officers were announced for the next year. A "floating" rally fee rather than a fixed fee was discussed and adopted and a committee was set up to review, revise and update the Club's bylaws.
